AWARDS

Ribbons for 1st through 4th place in class for each jump height class (dogs jumping 24" will be included with the 20"+ class). Green qualifying ribbons will be offered to every dog obtaining a qualifying score.

HIGH IN TRIAL rosettes will be awarded to the Novice, Open and Elite dogs, in the standard division. An overall HIT rosette will be awarded in the veterans and junior handler divisions. The highest point totals will win; ties to be broken by the fastest combined YPS. An Elite Q = 7 HIT points, an Open Q = 6 HIT points, a Novice Q = 5 HIT points. Faulted Q's will be given half the point value. The level the dog is entered in the regular classes will determine the award level for the standard division awards.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA). Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of ASCA and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. No entry will be accepted from a handler or dog disqualified from all ASCA programs or anyone not in good standing with ASCA.

This trial will be held on grass. Equipment list: Slat-less A-Frame, Dog Walk, Teeter, open tunnels, winged and non winged jumps, non-displaceable tire jump and weave poles (24" spacing).

****Did you know all dogs can receive ASCA® agility titles??****

ASCA requires a 'tracking' number for all non-ASCA registered dogs if you wish to have your scores recorded for ASCA titles. *If you are not concerned about ASCA titles, you do not have to ASCA -register your dog to enter and compete in the trial.* Forms for ASCA tracking numbers & service membership are included in this premium, available at the ASCA website, <http://asca.org/Forms/trackapp.pdf>, and will be available at the trial. A copy of the ASCA Agility Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA website: <http://www.asca.org> ASCA Agility will allow FEO (For Exhibition Only) entries if you would like to jump your dog at a jump height 4" lower than 'usual'. Come and practice (the judge will allow standard course time) if you feel you are not ready to compete 'for real' or need to work on special skills.

CLUB RULES FOR THE TRIAL

All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site.

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire, flooding, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be issued for bitches that come in season if notification in writing is received before February 1, 2012. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.

Class order will be determined by the judge and exhibitors will be notified in their confirmations. Please read them carefully, verify the accuracy of all the information and inform the trial secretary of any errors.

ASCA® Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA® registered dogs – In order to have ASCA® qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA® titling certificates, each non-ASCA® registered dog will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (minimum membership type of 'Service' is required). ASCA® membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA® the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA® qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.**
